Our fabulous 5th graders will also be tested in the curricular area of Science. Testing will begin on May 10th and conclude on Tuesday, May 18th. Testing begins at 8:10 a.m. and concludes at 10:10 a.m. every day during our testing window.

As you know, our students have been working hard all year to master their grade level standards so they can shine as Garden Park students. You can help your child experience academic success on this statewide assessment by making sure your child gets a good night of sleep, eats a nutritious breakfast, and comes to school on time. Individual student results should begin arriving in the mail near the end of August.

The week after state testing, the week of May 17th, the Garden Park community will have an opportunity to honor our teaching staff. Teachers work with our students over five hours a day. They teach our children, listen to our children, and guide our children through 180 days of school. Unique and special relationships have been developed and nurtured throughout the school year.
