- Diploma distribution (Wednesday) **June 22nd** Multipurpose room (after the ceremony)-***all fines must be cleared to receive your diploma!***

To take part in these activities, and participate in the graduation ceremony, *you must pay your \$50.00 graduation fee (cash only) at the Hare office before June 17th.* Refunds can only be issued if the cap and gown package is not opened.
