You are hereby notified of the following changes, additions, or deletions to the Documents for the above-titled Project. Take careful note of the addendum so that the proper allowances may be made.

1. See attached Questions Asked Verbatim on Pages 2 through 4.

Connie Cross Assistant Director of Business Services Q. Will the lease units price include carpet, vertical blinds and exterior paint to match existing school color body/trim?

A. Yes. We want carpet, blinds and paint on rental/leased buildings.

- Q. Are all building new or used to include sales taxes?
- A. No
- Q. Attachment D Line D4 (not used). Can you add 36x60 (open shell)?
- A. No
- Q. Are the standard DSA ada ramps 4x11/decks 5x7 and Handrails that come with bldgs. to be 2015 and newer with DSA 292 Forms?
- A. Yes
- Q. Are all items required to have pricing? Will not applicable (n/a) on items disqualify Bid?
- A. No
- Q. Do we provide a guarantee form for service response within 24hrs and within 3 hours repair to commence, if not provided will this disqualify Bid?
- A. We are requiring repairs to commence within 24 hours. Please provide a letter on company letter head that states you will perform repairs within 24 hours.
- Q. Will the district award multiple bidders?
- A. If more than 1 bidder is low in a building type, we will likely award to more than 1 bidder. We reserve that right to award to multiple bidders.
- Q. Confirming the basis of award is the 9-month lease total?
- A. The basis of award is lowest for 9 months of rent.
- Q. What size classroom will the 9 month lease total be based on?
- A. Each building type (i.e. used A-1, new A-1) will be awarded on the lowest for 9 months of rent.
- Q. How much are liquidated damages? Would the district remove this from the BID?
- A. Liquidated damages are \$500 per day. The district will not remove this from the BID.
- Q. Just to confirm the district is expecting PW on dismantle.
- A. Prevailing wages are required for all work done on school property.
- Q. Is bonding capacity required? If so, how much?
- A. Bonding capacity is not required.
- Q. Please clarify if roof mounted HVAC are optional but not required?
- A. Roof mounted units are not optional.

- Q. Ramps are priced in misc items, are they not to be included in the bldg. price for monthly rental rate?
- A. Ramps and handrails **must be** included in the cost of renting a building and purchasing a building. A miscellaneous item for ramps is included in the event the district needs to purchase ramps for existing buildings.
- Q. Will the district allow early termination fees? The BID states the district may terminate for convenience after a PO is issued?
- A. No
- Q. Will the district accept right-hand classrooms in lieu of left-hand classrooms? Are only left hand classrooms being bid?
- A. The District needs both right and left hand buildings. The price must be the same for right and left hand buildings.
- Q. Are we required to verify and measure field conditions?
- A. No
- Q. Is the district responsible for utility connections?
- A. Yes
- Q. Who is responsible for the soils report?
- A. The District will be responsible for the soils report(s).
- Q. Confirming that payment and performance bonds are required.
- A. Yes. Payment and Performance Bonds are required for projects valued at \$25,000 or greater.
- Q. What constitutes beneficial occupancy?
- A. Beneficial occupancy will be defined as when teachers, students or staff first use the building.
- Q. No cleaning fees are permitted in the bid; will Garden Grove accept damage charges that are caused by neglect, misuse, or vandalism?
- A. District will accept reasonable damage charges that may be caused by neglect, misuse or vandalism.
- Q. Will Garden Grove accept service work within 48 hours, instead of 3 hours per the bid?
- A. No. Work will be accepted within 24 hours.
- Q. Item 24 states that bidder must own vehicles for delivery + return, can this be removed from the bid?
- A. Bidders do not need to own vehicles.
- Q. Item 28 states that a bidder must have 5 years experience factor, will you accept bids from companies who have been in business less than 5 years?
- A. Yes. However, principals must have 5 years' experience.

- Q. Does vapor barriers need to be included in rental rate of bid? If so, does Garden Grove have a list of sites where vapor barrier would be needed?
- A. No
- Q. Do any of the classrooms need to be fire rated?
- A. No
- Q. What is the Floor load (psf) required on the kitchen buildings?
- A. The floor load must be 150 pounds per square foot.
- Q. Do any of the classrooms need to have upgraded floor loads?
- A. No
- Q. Will Garden Grove extend the bid due date, as item 9 states that bidders would have 10 days before bid deadline to have answers to questions from the district?
